

Saint Luke - 18th October



Luke's unique perspective on Jesus can be seen in the six miracles and eighteen parables not found in the other gospels. Luke's is the gospel of the poor and of social justice. Only in Luke's gospel do we hear Mary's

Magnificat. It is only in Luke's gospel that we hear the story of the Annunciation, Mary's visit to Elizabeth, the Presentation, and the story of Jesus' disappearance in Jerusalem. Only in Luke do we hear the story of the forgiven woman disrupting the feast by washing Jesus' feet with her tears. Through Luke's gospel, Jesus takes the side of the sinner who wants to return to God's mercy.

The Holy Father will canonise Blessed Oscar Romero on Sunday 14th October in Rome. So that people can join in the spirit of thanksgiving to mark the canonisation, Archbishop Malcolm will celebrate Mass at the Metropolitan Cathedral on Sunday 28th October at 11.00 am. All parishioners are welcome to attend.

<u>Prisoners' Sunday on 14th October 2018</u> is the national day of prayer and action for prisoners and their dependants as marked by the Catholic Church and across the Christian denominations. It is a day to direct our thoughts and prayers to prisoners and their families. Prisoners' Sunday is the time to reflect on how we as individuals, as a Church and as a community, are serving those affected by imprisonment.

This also marks the start of 'Prisons Week', in which we pray for those struggling to find reform, for the families of those in prison and for the victims of crime.
