#### The Advent Wreath



Today we light the first of our Advent candles. The four candles represent the four weeks of Advent. Three candles are purple and one is rose. The purple candles symbolize the prayer, sacrifices, and good works undertaken at this time. The rose candle is lit on the third Sunday, Gaudete

Sunday. The progressive lighting of the candles symbolizes the expectation and hope surrounding our Lord's first coming into the world and the anticipation of his second coming to judge the living and the dead. The light signifies Christ, the Light of the world.
